Safety Audit Standards for International Flight Operations Achieved

On October 18, 2013, Nippon Cargo Airlines (NCA, Headquartered in Narita-shi, Chiba: President Fukashi Sakamoto) renewed IOSA certificate, an international auditing program that recognizes operational safety that is managed by IATA. (the term of validity; two years)
